Schedule CEPS—Clean Energy and Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard Rider

RIDER CEPS – 1

Applicability:

Service under this Rider is applicable to all retail consumers of the Cooperative for the recovery of the Cooperative's incremental costs associated with meeting their Clean Energy and Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard (CEPS) pursuant to North Carolina General Statute 62-133.8 and NCUC Rule R8-67 (ratified by Senate Bill 678).

This Rider is not for resale service. The provisions of the Schedule with which the Rider is used are modified only as shown herein. Service rendered under this Rider is subject to the provision of the Cooperative's Service Rules and Regulation on file with the state regulatory commission.

Monthly Rate:

In addition to all other charges stated in the Monthly Rate Schedule with which this Rider is used, the following charges shall also apply:

Residential (Applicable to accounts 440, 440.1, and 440.2)	\$1.44	\$.56	\$2.00
Commercial (Applicable to accounts 441 and 442.1)	\$8.07	\$3.11	\$11.18
Industrial (Applicable to accounts 442.2, 442.3)	\$50.87	\$19.62	\$70.49

Definition:

1. Clean Energy and Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard (CEPS) Rate – The CEPS Rate shall be adjusted annually to reflect the incremental and development costs the Cooperative anticipates incurring for the upcoming year to comply with the North Carolina Clean Energy and Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard divided by the weighted number of consumers projected in each revenue class over the same twelve-month period.
2. Clean Energy and Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard Experience Modification Factor (CEPS EMF) – The CEPS EMF is a rate calculated annually to recover the difference between reasonably and prudently incurred CEPS costs and CEPS revenues realized during the period under review.

Applicable Taxes:

The total charges under the Rider will be increased by any applicable sales taxes imposed by any governmental authority.
